



KIPP Academy Lynn Charter Public School Lottery Application

My son/daughter wants to participate in KIPP Academy Lynn's enrollment lottery in February/March 2018 for entry into Grades K, 1, 2, 3, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, or 12 in August 2018. He/she is currently a Massachusetts resident. For Kindergarten applicants, he/she will turn 5 years old on or before September 1, 2018. Lotteries only take place if there are fewer seats available than applications submitted. In a lottery, names are drawn at random to fill open seats in each grade and all names not chosen to fill the open seats will be placed in order on a waitlist. Open seats may not be available for all grades. First priority is given to siblings of current KIPP Academy Lynn students and secondarily to Lynn residents.

Applications must be received by 5pm on February 21, 2018 to participate in the principal admission lottery for the 2018-2019 school year.

- 1. Fill out all information. Print neatly and clearly so we can read it.
- 2. Forms will only be accepted if hand-delivered, sent by mail, emailed to the above email addresses, or submitted electronically through our website at www.kippma.org. Applications will not be accepted via fax.
- 3. It is your responsibility to ensure that we receive the application. If you have not received a confirmation of receipt of your application by mail or by phone by Saturday, February 24, 2018, you must call the school by 5pm on Monday February 25, 2018 to verify that your information is on record for our admission lottery. Call 781-558-9263 for the elementary school and 781-598-1609 for the middle and high schools.
- 4. Verify that the child's date of birth and grade are 100% correct. You are responsible for updating any information that changes or is incorrect in your application.
- 5. Include working phone numbers only please give us more than one working phone number.
- 6. Include apartment numbers and the 5-digit zip code.
- 7. Apply for the grade your child will be entering in August 2018.
- 8. Inform us immediately if your address, phone number(s), or e-mail address changes.
- 9. Schedule your child's health physical in May or June. Every child will need to have a physical exam.
