




THE KIPP DIFFERENCE:

New Research Shows KIPP Public Schools are Closing the College Completion Gap

A new Mathematica study released in September, "Long-Term Impacts of KIPP Middle and High Schools on College Enrollment, Persistence, and Attainment" followed 2,066 students from ten regions, including students from KIPP Academy Lynn, who applied to join KIPP in 5th and 6th grade via an admissions lottery. These students graduated from high school in the classes of 2016, 2017, and 2019. The Mathematica study found that:

- Students who attended KIPP for both middle and high school were nearly twice as likely to persist and graduate from a four-year college as their peers who did not go to KIPP.
- Students were also 67% more likely to enroll in a four-year college than those who did not go to KIPP.

The impact of attending a KIPP middle and high school, extrapolated nationwide, would be large enough to nearly close the degree completion gap for Hispanic students or entirely close the degree-completion gap for Black students in the United States."





Pre-pandemic, we were on our way to meeting and exceeding the State average on the MCAS, but similar to the state, we saw a decrease of about 20% in our 2022 MCAS scores.



The Spring 2023 MCAS outcomes confirm both that our students made meaningful progress last year and that we have continued work to do. We are seeing positive growth and recovery in math, our highschoolers are on track to graduate, and our performance in ELA 3-8 demands a deeper commitment to providing more robust programming in literacy to increase growth and achievement.



ONE WAY KIPP MA IS ACCELERATING LEARNING: HIGH DOSE INDIVIDUALIZED TUTORING

In the Spring of 2023, 30 2nd grade students participated in our 8 week tutoring pilot with Ignite, which provides 20 minutes of individualized high dose tutoring with a virtual academic coach. Of those thirty students, 100% demonstrated growth from their pre to post test, and 50% of those students demonstrated over a half year of growth in those short 8 weeks. Through the use of philanthropic funds, this school year we hope to provide reading and math tutoring services for over 300 K-8 students across Boston and Lynn.



Research shows that the slower progress documented by these test scores should be fixed with small-group tutoring. Tutoring in small groups has significantly greater effect on student test scores than changes in class size, longer school days, or summer-school-type program.




the rate of economically disadvantaged students


