The last time I checked in with you, I shared updates on early action and early decision applications for our high school seniors. At this point in the year, applications have been submitted, and despite the challenges facing the entire nation with the new FAFSA structure, there's so much to celebrate. **97% of the class of 2024 has submitted at least one application** to a postsecondary program and**88% submitted their FAFSA** (compared to 32.3% nationally and 39.7% for the state of MA).




